They provide **free services** (not based on income) if your preschooler qualifies. The evaluation may lead to an **IEP** (Individual Education Plan) and your child could receive services from a public school program (for free) while your child is attending any preschool.

Also your preschooler would qualify for the Family Empowerment Scholarship- Unique Abilities (FES-UA). The FES-UA was formally known as the McKay & Gardiner Scholarships. If your preschooler has a documented diagnosis or an IEP, this can help pay for tuition and possible needed services at a private school come Kindergarten.
